

Just hook up two Xbox360's to the game over broadband, with the cable from one being plugged into the GamePort of the other, and there you go. If you've got a wireless router you can set it up as a wireless "hotspot" for up to eight machines. I know about that, but that's not what I was talking about. I want the system link feature. The only way i can play with a friend is through LAN, will it be included?. I've been wondering this as well. System link is what I'm hoping to do for co-op. System link is exactly what you're asking for. When you connect two consoles to a system link, your systems become one. You can use the single system link to play against your friends, while the other gets access to the shared library and is able to play co-op with other Xbox 360 gamers who connect to the link using their consoles. When you connect to a system link, you can see which system you're on. If you're playing alone, you can still use the features of the system link such as getting a list of your friends on the system and invite them to your game with no host required. Just make sure they've got an Xbox Live Gold account and they'll get the game even if it's not downloaded to their console. If you're both playing together, you can still use the features of the system link. And no, system link will not be included in the Live Arcade for the European launch of the game. This is because we decided that the system link feature didn't have enough benefits to justify including it at this time. But there's no way we'd be able to include it in the future unless the feature has a significant amount of change made to it. 82157476af
